Attached are sheets listing all positions for E&E Maintenance Supervisor and E&E Maintainer's & Helpers for use in the GENERAL PICK.

All employees in the above classifications will participate in this pick and will select in the order of seniority as shown on seniority list for their respective classifications. Employees who are in a no work status (AWOL, P.B., Sick/WOP, etc.) will not be eligible to PICK.

Employees, as indicated above are required to report for their selections, as indicated on schedule to be posted.

When vacancy occurs on a permanent pick job, bids may be posted to employees Junior to employee causing the vacancy except that in group jobs, bids commence from the junior employee in the group. All permanent employees who are serving provisionally in a higher title must appear at the pick and make their selection in regular order of seniority in their provisional classification. If a provisionally promoted employee is returned to his/her title, he/she will be reassigned.

Employees unable to attend the pick for reasons, such as short term or sudden sickness, vacation, etc., may select assignments in writing over their own signature, numbering their choices 1, 2, 3, 4, 5. These requests must be forwarded to:

by registered U.S. mail or personal messenger so that he may be informed of the selection at least forty-eight (48) hours before the pick is scheduled to commence. If this selection is received in time, when the absentee's name is reached on the seniority list, the committee will fill his/her top available choice and secure same for the absentee. No telephone, telegram, or fax pick is acceptable.

Employees participating in this selection during their regular tour of duty will do so without loss of pay but those who do participate in the selection during their off duty hours will not be paid for any time spent in making their selections. Employees medically qualified to perform "Restricted Duties" within their title either on a permanent or temporary basis will be assigned to pick jobs consistent with their ability to perform certain work, provided, however, that such budgeted pick jobs are available. "Restricted Duty" employees will be assigned to duties that they are able to perform in other departments, if available. NYC Transit Policy Instruction 6.12.1, Section 2.16 of the TWU Contractual Physical Disability Agreement, and Article 14 of the S.S.S.A. Contractual Agreement will apply for "Restricted Duty" assignments.

When an employee bids a job, his vacation may be subject to change upon consultation between the Union and the Superintendent.

Any employee who fails to follow the above procedure or who fails to appear by the time his/her name is reached on the preference seniority list, will lose his/her opportunity to pick and will be assigned by management to the position he/she held prior to the pick, if it is vacant. If this position is not vacant, he/she will be assigned to a position in accordance with his/her preference seniority and consistent with remaining unfilled positions.

Employees absent on official extended leave of absence because of Military Duty will be permitted to select a position in accordance with their preference seniority on their return to active duty with the NYC Transit.

Employees must be in full work status or permanent restricted duty and present a transit pass to be eligible to pick. Employees who have filed for retirement or have not been in a work status for 30 days or more will not be permitted to pick or be assigned. They will, upon return to a full duty active status, be assigned to available job openings. EXCEPTION: EMPLOYEES WHO ARE OUT SCI WHO PROVIDE PROOF OF A JOINT AGREEMENT FROM THEIR PERSONAL PHYSICIAN AND THE MAC AND WHO'S RETURN DATE IS PRIOR TO THE CHANGEOVER WILL BE PERMITTED TO PICK ANY FAILURE TO REPORT TO THE PICKED JOB AND MAINTAIN ATTENDANCE WILL RESULT IN THE JOB BEING BID. WHEN EMPLOYEES RETURN TO FULL DUTY THEY WILL BE ASSIGNED.

Employees selecting assignments, for which they are not qualified, will be assigned vacancies without choice.

Employees selecting a position that requires a Commercial Driver License (CDL) must have the license or a CDL class B permit. All drivers will operate any vehicle they are licensed for if necessary. Operators are responsible for the proper securing of load, operation, care, cleanliness and daily maintenance of the vehicles (fluids and fuel). (Vehicles will be driven only when required). Rule 4.(I) pertains to all vehicle operators.

There are jobs listed with an "X" at the end of the job number. All "X" designations indicate these positions exceed the approved budget quota. Employees selecting "X" jobs are not eligible to bid for jobs they could have picked. Employees picking these jobs will be canvassed to fill vacancies that occur during the life of this pick. Federal and State laws require drivers to inspect their vehicles to ensure the safe operation of the vehicle. The driver must:

Watch gauges for signs of trouble and ensure they are operable.

Use your senses to check for problems (look, listen, smell and feel).

Check critical items such as. Tires and rims, Front and rear wheel seals for leaks, Brakes, Lights, Mirrors, Brake and electrical connections to trailers, Trailer coupling devices, Mud flaps, Fire extinguishers, seat belts, Check fluid levels (engine oil, engine coolant, transmission fluid); Utilize cargo securing devices such as nets, straps and chains (these devices must be applied to ensure that all material remains secured on the truck).

Particular attention should be given to hazardous materials that pose a risk to health, safety and property during transportation. The rules require diamond shaped warning signs on vehicles transporting hazardous material. Some examples of hazardous materials are diesel fuel, gasoline, pesticides and compressed gas. Specifically, if you are transporting compressed gases, the vehicle must have racks to hold cylinders. Alternatively, the cargo space must be flat and the cylinders must be held upright or braced laying down flat or in boxes that will keep them from turning over. The driver must have a Commercial Driver's License with the applicable hazardous endorsement before driving vehicles with placards.

Explanation of Specific Job Notes:

A – Bridge Personnel:

A training will be required for any employee who has not received proper training on the bridge.

Bridge personnel must remain proficient in the operation of the bridge at all times.

By the end of the training period, personnel must demonstrate to supervision an ability to properly operate and maintain the bridge. If employee cannot perform the required functions they will be assigned any existing vacant job or if none are available reassigned as to the needs of NYCT. Canvassing personnel by seniority will then fill the vacant bridge job.

B - Truck Driver:

Employees who pick these jobs must have valid commercial driver's license (CDL). Those employees that do not have a CDL may pick these positions, however they must obtain a CDL permit within 30 days: at which time NYCT will schedule the employee for driver training and a road test appointment. If the employee fails to obtain the required CDL permit he/she will be reassigned in accordance with the business needs of the authority.

C – Qualification period:

These jobs require computer skills. Therefore a three-week training period will be provided to any employee who has no prior NYCT related computer experience. Incumbent will have thirty days after training to demonstrate satisfactory ability to perform the duties of this job. If found not acceptable, personnel will be reassigned to any existing vacant job or if none is available reassigned as to the needs of NYCT. Canvassing personnel by seniority will then fill the vacant computer job.

D – Training / Absentee Relief:

Employees who pick these jobs will be utilized as "training / absentee relief" and will be required to work a job on any tour that is vacant as a result of another employee being absent from their picked job. When filling the vacant job the employee will assume the RDO'S of the job being covered. Normally these employees will cover jobs within the sub-division (North, South or Operations Support) to which they are assigned and for the full duration of the absence; not to exceed eight weeks. When not being used for training / absentee relief the employee will be assigned to the tour and RDO'S as indicated .Employees that pick these jobs will be given a minimum of three day notice if a change of tour is required. In addition changes to these employees' regular days off (RDO) will be limited to eight occasions within a calendar year. These employees will also be paid travel time if their reporting location is changed.

E – Lock In:

Employees who pick these jobs will be **locked in for a two-year period**. After two years only one maintainer will be allowed to pick in or out of the group based on seniority.

F – Heavy Lifting/Forklift Operation:

Employees who pick these jobs will be subject to lifting heavy equipment and may be required to operate a forklift (training will be provided).

G - QEI:

Supervisors in these positions must be certified as a Qualified Elevator Inspector by an organization accredited by ANSI.

H - Bridge Coverage:

This job must be Bridge Qualified as in Note: A, will be required to directly report on/off at the Bridge as required. Employees who pick these jobs are subject to change without penalty according to operational needs of the NYCT.

When not being used for training / absentee relief the employee will be assigned to the tour and RDO'S as indicated .Employees that pick these jobs will be given a minimum of three day notice if a change of tour is required. In addition changes to these employees' regular days off (RDO) will be limited to eight occasions within a calendar year. These employees will also be paid travel time if their reporting location is changed.
