

MAINTENANCE OF WAY - TRACK EQUIPMENT MAINTAINER SECTION

Ballot Instructions

1. Look down the left side of each ballot to see how many candidates you can vote for, for each office.
2. If you vote for more candidates than authorized for any

position, your vote for all candidates for that position will be void.

3. For a Slate vote on the "Section Ballot" mark [X] in the slate box. The vote for a slate on your ballot will be counted as a vote for every slate candidate on that ballot.
4. If you are not voting a straight slate, mark [X] in the box before the name of each candidate of your choice.
5. Do not sign your name on this ballot or on the "Secret Ballot" envelope, or your ballot will be void. The envelope cannot be used to reveal how you voted, since the Secret Ballot will be separated from the

return envelope and mixed with the other Secret Ballot envelopes before it is opened. The process assures the secrecy of your vote.

6. Place your marked ballot in the envelope marked "Secret Ballot" and seal the envelope. Place the Secret Ballot envelope in the return addressed envelope. The return address label must be completely filled out.
7. The voted ballot must be mailed so it arrives at the Post Office no later than 8:30AM on Monday, April 22, 2010.
8. The ballot count will be at the Union Hall Monday, April 22, 2010 at 10AM.
