TWU Local 100 Elections Committee Eligibility Report

Pursuant to the Election Rules, Nominating Petitions were due back by 6:00 P.M. Friday, June 2, 2017. In all, 126 petitions were filed with a total of 5,102 signatures, by 12 independent candidates. The Candidates or their authorized representatives had two days to review the Petitions and make whatever written objections they wished to make by close of business Tuesday June 6, 2017. A number of objections were filed asserting that certain signatures were illegible.

All legible signatures on all Petitions were checked against the Union's current list of good standing members (members who do not owe dues). The signatures of members in bad standing or not active were deducted. In the course of this check, signatures without pass numbers were not counted and signatures that did not match pass numbers were not counted. Where a signature was difficult to read but the pass number indicated a name that bore some relationship to the signature, the signature was counted. If someone signed in a division or department for which s/he was not eligible to sign, that signature was deducted. This resulted in the "Potentially Valid" number. The last step was to eliminate any duplicate signatures, which resulted in the "Total Valid" number.

In the Report below we set forth the total number of signatures submitted for each candidate, the number which were left after deductions were made (called "Potentially Valid"), and the total number of valid signatures remaining after duplicates were eliminated ("Total Valid"). Where a candidate is not eligible, that is indicated. All candidates <u>not</u> noted to be ineligible submitted enough valid signatures to be eligible for the position for which they were nominated.

The Independent candidates will be placed on the ballot ranked by the number of valid signatures as set forth below.

Any party who wishes to contest the determination of the Elections Committee has 48 hours from the date of this Report to appeal to the Neutral Monitor.
