Candidates,

Candidate Evangeline Byars has gone to court seeking an extension of time for her file petitions because she has had to "to receive medical treatment for the emotional and mental distress [from]... harassment" from the Election Committee. Rather than engage in a protracted hearing, the Local and the International agreed to extend the deadline, but are doing so for **all** candidates, not just Byars. The deadline is extended till 9:00 am sharp on Monday October 4, 2021. The Election Committee will be present in the office to accept filings between 7am and 9am on October 4. All other dates and time deadlines in the Rules continue in effect, including the opportunity to examine and challenge filed petitions, which begins at 9:30 am on October 4th through 6pm on October 5th. All objections must be filed by 6pm on October 5, 2021.

NO OTHER DEADLINES OR REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN CHANGED, AND THE NUMBER OF SIGNATURES REQUIRED, WITNESS RULES, ETC REMAINS THE SAME.

We encourage candidates to file by **5pm on October 1, 2021**, if they have a sufficient number of signatures so that the Committee can complete its review work in a timely manner.
