Your complaint to the Department of Labor protesting the December 8, 2021, election of officers in Transport Workers Union of America, Local 100, in Brooklyn, New York, has been investigated pursuant to Sections 402 and 601 of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959.

Following a review of the investigative findings by this office and the Office of the Solicitor, Division of Civil Rights and Labor-Management, a decision has been made that those findings do not provide a basis for action by the Department to set aside the protested election.
