“I never took a penny from an employee”

I’ve made a big profit off my drivers’ hard work by refusing to pay overtime

“Trans Express has been working directly with the Department of Labor”

Trans Express is under investigation for wage theft from its employees

“The union has no power to force National Express to change the wage structure...”

I’m ignoring the 83-year history of TWU Local 100 winning big gains for working people – including at a National Express company in Westchester.

“I cannot fix what I don’t know”

I didn’t know that my drivers get the lowest pay in the industry. I didn’t know my drivers don’t get holiday pay. (Yeah right)

What Mary Doesn’t Want You to Know:

TWU bus drivers make an average of \$31/hour. At White Plains Bus (a National Express company, the same employer as Trans Express) Big bus drivers get \$25.31 an hour, Matrons make \$17.79 an hour, and all employees get 12 paid holidays a year.

When Mary says, “everyone is tired of this union thing,” we say: **“No, everyone is tired of being abused on the job.”**

At National Express Westchester, employees get 2 weeks vacation after 1 year, 3 weeks after 5 years, 4 weeks after 12 years, and five weeks vacation after 20 years of service.
