The Murphy Institute's <u>Certificate in Labor Studies</u>, offered in partnership with your TWU Training and Upgrading Fund, is a 16-credit program designed for eligible TWU Local 100 members, officers and staff who want to study the social, political and cultural impact that the organization of work has on employees and their communities...with tuition reimbursed through TUF!

Courses offered one night a week. Come take your first 4 CUNY credits toward your 16-credit **Labor Studies Certificate** and a **College Degree!****

<u>Course Location/Schedule:</u> During the Fall 2017 Semester, courses will likely be held at the Training and Upgrading Fund, 4th floor 195 Montague Street. The previous semester's class was offered on Thursdays from 5:30pm – 8:50pm.

Other classes may be held at the Murphy Institute (25 W. 43rd St. 19th Floor) or the Worker Institute at Cornell (16 E. 34th St. 6th Floor) in Midtown Manhattan.

<u>Admission:</u> High school diploma or proof of GED required for admission. Open to eligible TWU members (please visit the <u>Tuition Reimbursement site</u> for details). Deadline to apply is **July 27, 2017** for the term starting in late August 2017.

<u>Course Credit and Tuition:</u> This course earns 4 undergraduate credits from CUNY School of Professional Studies. Tuition is \$275.00 per credit OR \$1100.00 per course *for New York State Residents*. There is a \$70 application fee (reimbursable by the TUF), a \$25.00 student activity fee, and a \$77.50 consolidated and technology fee each term (payable by the student).

When you complete the course you will be reimbursed for the tuition and eligible fees. If you drop out/fail or otherwise do not succeed in completing the class, you <u>will not</u> be reimbursed. There is a payment plan available through CUNY if you cannot lay out all the money at once.
