## **TWU LOCAL 100 Petition Procedure**

Beginning at 9:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M. on Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup>, through Monday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 9: 00 A.M. – 6:00 P.M., at the Transport Workers Union Local 100 Hall, located at 1700 Broadway 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, New York, N.Y., 10019, nominating petitions for the Schoolbus/Paratransit Division, Executive Board, will be distributed and logged on a first come, first serve basis. To create and maintain order the following rules will govern the distribution procedure. Candidates will be given a package of petitions for the SchoolBus/Paratransit Division. Packages of petitions will be prepared in advance by the Elections Committee. A maximum of ten (10) petitions can be picked up by any <u>member in good standing</u>, from Schoolbus/Paratransit Division, (who has submitted an "Authorization to pick-up a Petition form), at one time. Packages of petitions will be distributed to authorized representatives as close to simultaneously as possible, but in the order they were lined up before 9:00 A.M. Once the authorized representative has been given a package of petitions s/he may take them out of the building to distribute them to others to solicit signatures.

Candidates need **fifty** (**50**) signatures of <u>members in good standing</u> to be nominated.

Only members in good standing may witness a petition. A member is not prohibited from signing petitions for more than one (1) candidate. If a member has signed more than once for the same candidate, only one signature will be counted and the duplicate signature(s) will be disregarded.

No petitions will be accepted after 6:00 P.M., July 15, 2013.

Please note that the Elections Committee is mandated to keep the number of signatures solicited by any candidate confidential until after **6:00 P.M**. on **Monday, July 15, 2013.**
