DECISION

Protest I-21-15 (Creegan)
Posting Petition receipts

By email dated November 11, 2015, Thomas Creegan filed a protest in which he seems to allege that the Elections Committee violated the Election Rules when it refused to post online the receipts given to those turning in Nomination Petitions on or before October 2.

To the extent this Protest is an objection to the remedy ordered in TWUS-07-15 related to Petitions submitted by Donald Yates, it should have been addressed to the TWU Committee on Appeals. To the extent that this is a new Protest, unrelated to the decision in TWUS-07-15, it is untimely, as the petitioning period ended over a month ago. Further, the Protester has not articulated any reason for his request, other than to speculate, without foundation, that Petitions may have been turned in after the October 2 deadline.

The protest is denied.

In accordance with the International Constitution and the Election Rules, any interested party unsatisfied with this determination may appeal to the Transport Workers Union of America Committee on Appeals. Any appeal shall be in writing and shall be filed in accordance with the procedure set forth in Article V(6)(I)(1) of the Election Rules and Articles XV and XXII of the International Constitution for the appeal to the International from decisions of Local Unions.
