Your union is happy to report that your contract fully protects your guaranteed hours and weeks against a Coronavirus shutdown or suspension of service by your company.

Only one company has so far reported a suspension because of school cancellation. Those members are getting paid their hours, per the contractual agreement. Please let your union reps know immediately if your company suspends service, and especially if they do not comply with the contract as it relates to your pay.

COMPANIES REPORT EXTENSIVE CLEANING INITIATIVE

All of our School Bus companies are going the extra mile on safety. They have implemented a comprehensive cleaning regimen to protect the children and the workers from unnecessary risk from the coronavirus.

First Mile Square, Royal Coach (Yonkers and Ossining), White Plains, Supertrans, Vallo/Mutual and Student Transportation of America (STA) report that the buses are being cleaned on a daily basis. First Mile Square is doing the daily cleaning and fumigating on the weekends. Quality is spraying every other day, and they are planning to spray the buses with a new disinfectant that lasts from 60 to 90 days.

If there is any deviation on the cleaning from what they companies are telling us, please report it immediately to your union representative.
