| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Look down the left side of the ballot to see how many candidates you can vote for office. 2. If you vote for more candidates than authorized for any position, your vote for all candidates for that position will be void. 3. For a slate vote on the ballot mark an (X) in the (slate) box. The vote for a slate will be counted as a vote for each slate candidate on the ballot . 4. You have an option to vote for individual candidates by marking an (X) in the box to the left of the candidates name. | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Place your marked ballot in the envelope marked “Secret Ballot”, and seal the envelope. Place the Secret Ballot envelope in the return addressed envelope. <u>The voted ballot must be mailed so it arrives at the Post Office no later than 8:30 AM on Friday, March 29,2019</u> 6. <u>Do not sign your name on this ballot</u>, or on the “Secret Ballot” envelope, or your ballot will be void. The envelope cannot be used to reveal how you voted, since the Secret Ballot will be separated from the return envelope and mixed with the other Secret Ballot envelope before it is opened. The process assures the secrecy of your vote. |
