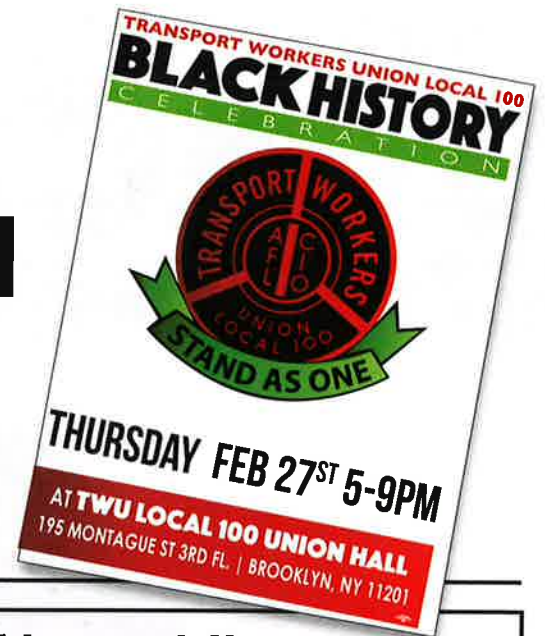

Are You Entitled to a Reimbursement For Medicare Part B ?



**Retirees on Medicare must be enrolled in Part B.
The current cost of Part B is \$144.60 monthly.
This is deducted from your Social Security Check.**

**As a TA/OA/MTA Bus Retiree, YOU ARE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT.
The amount of reimbursement depends on the Medical Plan that you select:**



Aetna CPPO II Basic	→	\$297.60 Annual Reimbursement
Aetna Option 1	→	\$297.60 Annual Reimbursement
Aetna Option 2	→	\$1,735.20 Annual Reimbursement <i>(Spouse on Medicare is reimbursed \$1,735.20 as well.)</i>

Medicare Part B Reimbursement *Don't Miss Out!*

The reimbursement is only made payable upon filing a claim with the **MTA Business Service Center (646-376-0123)** and providing the appropriate documentation (SS 1099). Once you file the claim, you are placed on the permanent file and the reimbursement will occur annually without having to file again unless you are contacted by the MTA Business Service Center.
