This map depicts planned service in the event of certain severe weather conditions. Service operates in portions of the system that are protected from the elements.

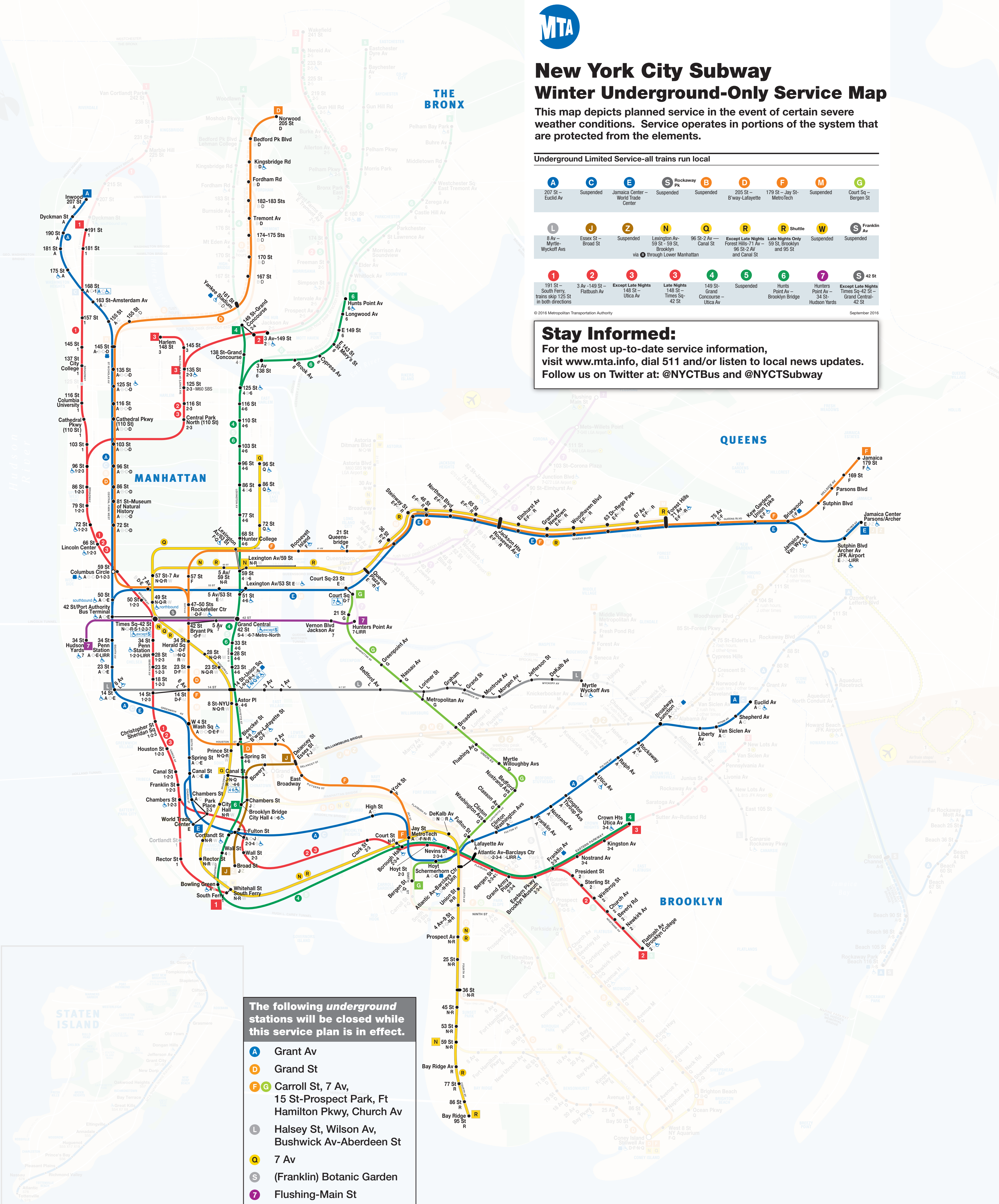
