BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Look down the left side of the ballot to see how many candidates you can vote for the office.
2. If you vote for more candidates than authorized, your vote for all candidates will be void.
3. Mark [X] in the box above the name of the candidate of your choice.
4. Do not sign your name on this ballot or on the **SECRET BALLOT** envelope, or your ballot will be void. The envelope cannot be used to reveal how you voted, since the **SECRET BALLOT** envelope will be separated from the return envelope and mixed with the other **SECRET BALLOT** envelopes before it is opened. The process assures the secrecy of your vote.
5. Place your marked ballot in the envelope marked **SECRET BALLOT** and seal the envelope. Place the **SECRET BALLOT** envelope in the return addressed envelope.
6. The voted ballot must be mailed so it arrives at the Post Office no later than 8:30AM on Thursday, October 6, 2010.
7. The ballot count will be held at the American Arbitration Association, Thursday, October 6, 2010.
