Looking to **JUMPSTART** your career? **ADVANCE** within your current job?

If so, the **ELEVATE PROGRAM** is a good career track option for you.

In response to the urgent needs of the Transit Authority concerning Capital Construction, Subway Infrastructure, and the retiring workforce, the Training and Upgrading Fund, in partnership with the Electrical Training Center created the Elevate program.

Elevate is a program that was designed to provide workers with requisite skills and training. Members in unskilled titles can gain a new skill-set and become eligible to qualify for the Transit Electrical Helper exam. Working as a helper, may afford promotional opportunities after one (1) year in the title to become maintainer.



Our first Elevate program was a success with 25 graduates in October of 2021. Recently, they applied for and took the Transit Electrical Helper exam. Many of our graduates with dedication and commitment have passed the Civil Service exam and are on their way to becoming transit electrical helpers. In March of 2022, our second class of 24 began and will graduate this fall. Our next registration will take place in January 2023, so keep an eye out for it.

- Urban Studies in Electronics (4 College Credits) 15 weeks (NEW)



#### Latoya Edwards



I will never forget January 4th, 2019 receiving my letter stating "Dear Member: Congratulations! You have been accepted into the TWU Local 100 Upward Advancement Program. Report to the following: APEX Technical School".

Upon receiving this letter, I was beyond grateful. My job at the time was in the Department of Security as a Transit Property Protection Agent. As much as I enjoyed working in my previous department, I desired to advance in my career. I have applied for numerous positions at Transit without success. I lacked computer skills. As a mother of two young children, I knew I had to improve my skills, not only as a mother, but as an individual as well. 
