These are one year scholarships. However, members in good standing may submit one application each year for the same or a different student.

Applicants for the TWU Local 100 Scholarships must be either TWU Local 100 or TWU Local 100 Retirees' Association members, or children or grandchildren of members in good standing. They must also be attending or accepted by an accredited two or four year college.

Eighty \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded at random to qualified applicants.

Winners will be announced in The Transit Workers Bulletin and will be invited to attend our annual scholarship reception accompanied by their spouse, parents, grandparents or guest.

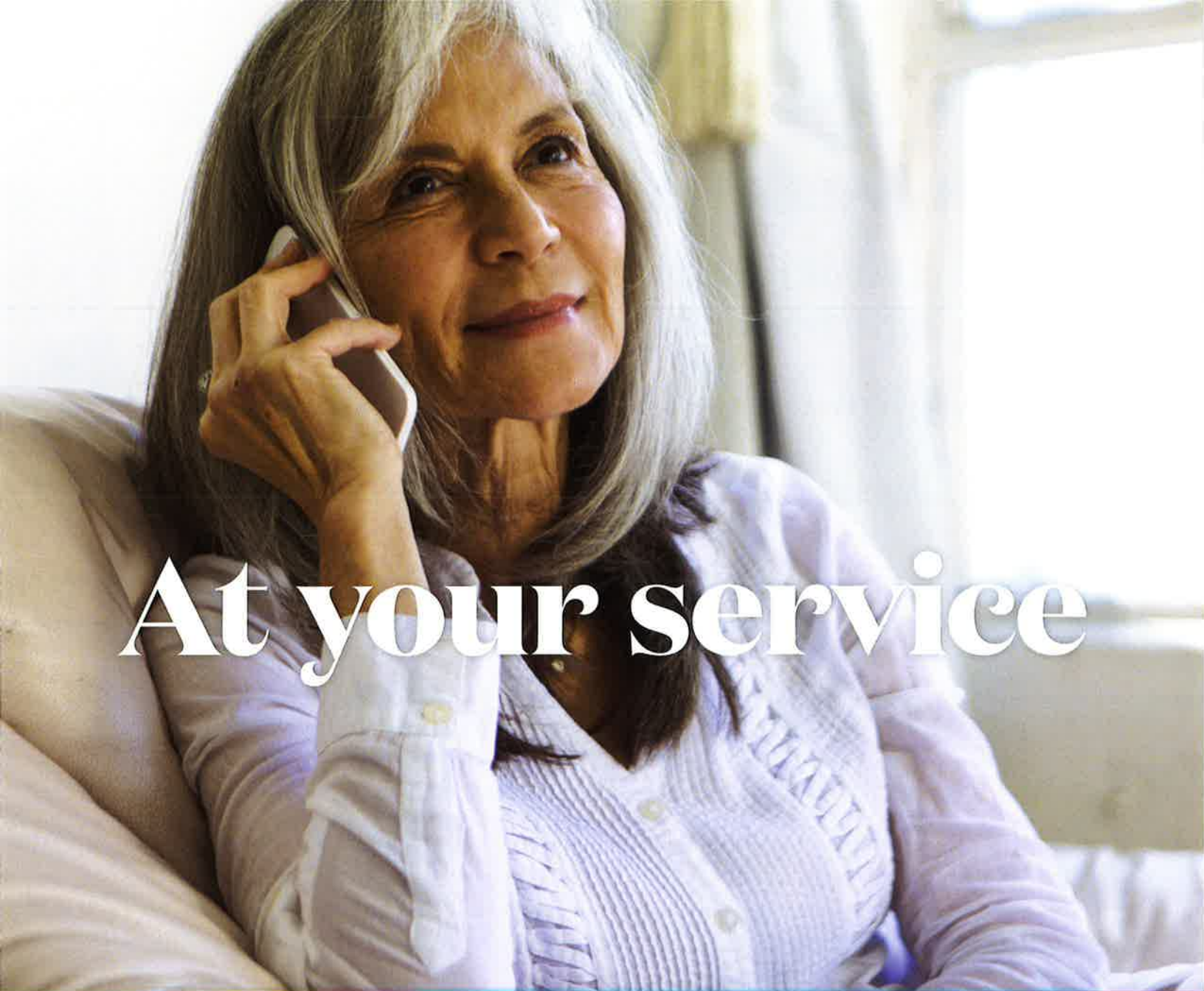
