DECISION

Protest I-14-2024 (use of Union
resources)

By email dated October 4, 2024 at 11:22 AM, Edward Gajda filed a protest alleging that Local 100 and the Members First Slate were guilty of improper contribution of Union resources to the slate when Members First posters were posted on the inside of the Maintenance Union office at Gun Hill Depot facing out on October 3. As a remedy, the Protester asks that the posters be removed. Upon notice to the Union and the Members First Slate, the posters were immediately removed as requested. I was notified by the Slate at 7:41 PM that the posters had been removed.

Protest granted. No further remedy required. The Slate is cautioned that Union resources must be equally available to all candidates and slates.

In accordance with the International Constitution and the Election Rules, any interested party unsatisfied with this determination may appeal to the Transport Workers Union of America Committee on Appeals. Any appeal shall be in writing and shall be filed in accordance with the procedure set forth in Article IV(B)(9) of the Election Rules and Article XXII of the International Constitution for the appeal to the International from decisions of Local Unions.
