The Mask Force Wants You! Support Our Frontline Heroes

We're going to do that by handing out masks.

Thousands of masks on two days next week, to any customer who needs one.

We also know positive reinforcement can help change behavior and turn non-mask wearers into mask wearers.

So, July 20 and 23, we're going to work together to hand out masks to customers traveling with us.

We need 600 volunteers to work a 2.5 hour shift handing out masks on Monday, July 20, or Thursday, July 23. You'll be handing out masks as a courtesy, you're not there to enforce compliance, and can move along if the customer isn't interested.

Here's how it will work, once you sign up:

1. You'll head to your starting location and meet your team leader.

You'll get a KN95 mask for yourself, a t-shirt, disposable gloves, and a small box filled with masks (Tip: you might want to bring a backpack to hold extra masks and your supplies).
You'll get a partner and an assignment, and head off to hand out masks! You and your partner will travel along a line and switch between cars at each station to hand out masks on the train. Or, you'll hand out on a bus and hop off to board a new bus at the next stop.
After your 2.5 hour shift is done, you'll check out with your team leader and head back to work or home.

We hope you <u>sign up</u>. You'll be standing in solidarity with the thousands of our colleagues who showed up day in and day out during the worst part of this pandemic, and you'll be helping make the city safer for everyone.
