FROM MANHATTAN: East Side: Take the F.D.R. Drive North to Bruckner Expressway (towards I-95 North). Get off at Exit 10 (Gun Hill Road) Drive approximately ½ mile 10 Eastchester Road. At Eastchester Road make a right. After 1/2 mile the Eastwood Manor is on left. West Side: Take the West Side Highway to the Cross Bronx Expressway (towards I-95 North). Get off at Exit 10 (Gun Hill Road) Drive approximately 1/2 mile to Eastchester Road make a right. After 1/2 mile The Eastwood Manor is on left Side. FROM BROOKLYN: Take the Whitestone Bridge to 1-95 North. Get off at Exit 10 (Gun Hill Road). Drive approximately 1/2 mile to Eastchester Road At Eastchester Road make a right. ## A Film and Discussion About the Crisis in Long-term Care PSC-CUNY 61 Broadway 16th Floor

ABOUT THE FILM: CARE, by Deirdre Fishel and Tony Heriza, shines a light on the relationships at the heart of the most supportive and sustainable long-term care option that we have: paid in-home caregiving. 90% of Americans wish to age at home but many cannot depend exclusively on their family and friends for their needs and so they rely on the critical, compassionate and skilled services of paid care workers. Shown through the eyes of both care workers and their clients, CARE illuminates the complexities of care work, as well as the life-changing attachments that often develop between care workers and those who receive it. The film urges viewers to consider the many barriers that keep people from doing this admirable work and others from receiving the care they need and deserve. The film was broadcast on PBS on September 5, 2017.

ABOUT THE ISSUE: At some point in our lives, we will all need care. This need is growing; the U.S. elder population will double over the next two decades and our system is unprepared for this elder boom. Inhome care work is one of the most affordable and desired long-term care solutions available yet this work is often unheralded and severely undervalued. Many families struggle to access and afford the highly skilled care they so desperately need. The situation is untenable. The stakes are high. We need a new way forward. The Caring Majority is fighting for it by organizing to win universal health and long-term care and an investment in dignified care jobs.
