PUBLIC EMPLOYEES WERE THE FIRST RESPOND-ERS ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2001. Transit workers helped get people out of the stations under the WTC and kept buses rolling to evacuate thousands from lower Manhattan. Transit workers were the first to arrive with heavy equipment to begin rescue efforts and stayed for weeks. Back then, they called us heroes. Now they're saying that public employees are lazy and overpaid.

Despite the sacrifices public workers have made, we're being blamed for the financial problems of the state and city. We're told we must sacrifice our wages and benefits and the pensions of the next generation of workers. Meanwhile, Wall St banks are raking in record profits. They are sacrificing nothing.
