#### **BASIC ELECTRICITY**

Members will be taught basic electricity principles, how to understand electrical circuts, how to understand electrical drawings and symbols, generators and transformers, electric motor, electrical protections, industrial wiring. In addition, they will learn about high voltage electrical safety. \*Math Assessment Required

\*The Math Assessment test is required prior to the start of the class. If you do not pass the test, you are required to take a basic math course before you can register for the Basic Electricity course. Math Assessments are available upon request, no appointment needed. Assessments are offered weekdays between 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.


# ELECTRICITY TROUBLESHOOTING

Members will be taught electrical safety requirements during system installation and equipment maintainance, testing procedures, electrical testing on low voltage equipment, medium voltage equipment, troubleshooting, remote instrumentation and online monitoring systems, grounding system maintenance and testing requirements, high voltage testing and troubleshooting, and power transformer troubleshooting

#### **Basic Math**

Basic Math will prepare members for the Transit Certificate Program (TCP), Upward Advancement Program and/or college level courses. Topics include addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, scientific measurements, algebra and much more.




