- MTA employees are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine. We strongly encourage everyone to get vaccinated. Do it for yourself, your family, your loved ones, and your colleagues.
- Every vaccine type was tested and approved for emergency use authorization by the U.S. FDA.
- Visit the MTA COVID-19 Employee Resource Center online for information and hours of operation for the MTA's dedicated employee vaccination sites. Employees can schedule appointments online or walk in.
- You can also walk into any city or state-run vaccination site without an appointment.
- After you get vaccinated, don't forget to upload your vaccine card at the MTA COVID-19 Employee Resource Center.
- Continue to wear a mask and follow all COVID-19 safety guidelines after being vaccinated.
